



## Directions to Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona

We will be using three rooms in the **Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona**: **Auditorio Meyer** (where also some panels and roundtables will be), **Aula 0** and **Auditorio del Convent** (where some events will be). These are located at different entrances to the Museum, see below:



To reach the museums, the easiest path is to cut across CCCB once you cross the street from the main university building (Facultat de Geografia i Història). Once you come to the other side of the courtyard, the building on your right has two of the rooms: Meier and Aula 0. Aula 0 is simply through the main entrance. Indicated by the top red circle, is the entrance to the Meier: this is entered from just outside the building, going down some stairs as pictured here.

If you walk around the main building you will reach the Paca dels Angels square, where you will see the Convent dels Angels.




## Directions to Facultat de Filologia

## Directions to Museu Marítim



The way to the Museu Marítim de Barcelona takes 18 minutes at a brisk walk, or 16 minutes via public transport, 11 minutes in the car.

The Metro takes you very close if you walk 10 minutes to Plaça de Catalunya stop and come out at Drassanes:
