Society, Science, Progress: Lewis Henry Morgan (1818-1881)

It is with great pleasure that the Department of Ethnology and Anthropology at the University of Belgrade with the support of the COTA (Commission on Theoretical Anthropology, IUAES), HoAn (History of Anthropology Network, EASA) and History and Philosophy of Science and Technology, multidisciplinary program, University of Belgrade, invites you to participate in the conference *Society, Science, Progress: Lewis Henry Morgan (1818-1881)*.

The conference, that will take place in Belgrade, Serbia, on the 30th of November 2018, is inspired by the 200th anniversary of Lewis Henry Morgan's birth. This important, yet controversial, figure of American and World anthropology had a great influence on anthropologists during and after his time. His impact on understanding of social evolution, kinship, progress and its dimensions, left an indelible mark in the history of this discipline. The goal of our conference is to detect and think through Morgan's work on modulating social theory and explaining cultural perspectives through language, kinship and other important elements of culture. Moreover, we will question current relevance of those topics and discuss a change in anthropology from the perspective of methodology, choices and approaches that are made by researches (in sense of scientific explanations and theory construction).

Proceedings from the conference will be published, as an edited, peer-reviewed book. Working languages of the conference: Serbian, Croatian and English.
