The Executive Committee of EASA welcomes you as a new member of the Association. EASA provides several activities for its members:

- EASA produces Social Anthropology/Anthropologie Sociale four times a year, which is included in the membership fees, and is available both online and optionally in hardcopy.
- EASA supports a book series (Berghahn Books).
- Members may participate in existing thematic networks as an "active member" or simply become a member of the network(s) mailing list (in order to be kept informed about events and participate in online discussions).
- The Association organises biennial conferences. Members can propose a panel, a round table, or a paper in these events. Members also pay reduced registration rates.
- Members may access (and are included within) the online directory of members which allows searching of (and communication with) colleagues by name, location, institution, and areas of interest: a valuable networking tool.
- The EASA Newsletter is emailed to members three times a year.
- The EASA website provides a wide range of information relating to the Association's activities and to anthropology in the world.

Besides these activities and services, members have several rights according to EASA's Constitution. All members may:

- Participate and vote at the Association's Annual General Meetings (AGMs) and Members' Forum
- Participate in elections to the Executive Committee (biennially)

In addition Full members may:

- Be nominated as candidates to the Executive Committee
- Propose candidates to the Executive Committee
- Propose honorary members to the Executive Committee

• Apply for different posts, such as Secretary, Treasurer, or editor of the journal, the book reviews, or the book series, when they are advertised.

Membership will be renewed automatically annually unless you inform us that you wish to terminate. Consequently, we will invoice for new subscriptions each year.
